As you are aware, the Commission with the concurrence of Ministry of Education had notified 'The University Grants Commission (Establishment and Operation of Academic Bank of Credits in Higher Education) Regulations, 2021" in the Gazette of India on 28th July, 2021. It was felt that Universities and Autonomous Colleges satisfying sub-regulation (2) of regulation 1 and the Institutions of National Importance as declared by the Government of India and specially empowered by an Act of Parliament to confer or grant degrees, irrespective of their NAAC or NIRF ranking should be able to participate and register in the Academic Bank of Credits. In this regard, the amendments have been notified in the Gazette of India on 28th December, 2021 and is available on the UGC website www.ugc.ac.in.

New Delhi, the 28th December, 2021

University Grants Commission (Establishment and Operation of Academic Bank of Credits in Higher Education) (First Amendment) Regulations, 2021

F. No. 14-31/2018(CPP-II).—In exercise of the powers conferred by clauses (f) and (g) of sub-Section (1) of Section 26 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956, the University Grants Commission with the approval of the Central Government hereby makes the following amendment in the University Grants Commission (Establishment and Operation of Academic Bank Of Credits in Higher Education) Regulations, 2021 [Notification No. 14-31/2018(CPP-II) dated 28th July, 2021] (hereinafter referred to as 'the Principal Regulations'), namely:

Short title and commencement — (1) These regulations may be called the University Grants Commission (Establishment and Operation of Academic Bank of Credits in Higher Education) (First Amendment) Regulations, 2021.

(2) These shall come into force on the date of its publication in the Official Gazette.

In sub regulation 1 of the Regulations 7 of the principal regulations following shall be substituted, namely:

(1) Universities and Autonomous Colleges satisfying sub-regulation (2) of regulation 1 and the Institutions of National Importance as declared by the Government of India and specially empowered by an Act of Parliament to confer or grant degrees.

The sub regulation 2 of regulations 7 shall be omitted.

Sub regulations 3, 4, 5 and 6 of regulation 7 shall be read as 2, 3, 4 and 5 respectively.

Note: The principal regulations were published in the Gazette of India, Extraordinary Part III, Section 4 vide F. No. 14-31/2018(CPP-II) dated 28th July, 2021.
