Immediate attention of the District Minorities Welfare Officers/ District Nodal Officers in the State is invited to the subject and reference cited.

It is to inform that, the Ministry of Minority Affairs implements three scholarship schemes i.e., Pre-Matric, Post Matric and Merit-cum-Means based scholarship schemes for the Minorities as Central Sector Schemes through National Scholarship Portal (NSP) URL: [www.scholarships.gov.in](http://www.scholarships.gov.in) with 100 % central funding. Under these schemes scholarships are awarded to the economically weaker and meritorious students from the six centrally notified communities i.e., Buddhist, Christian, Jain, Muslim, Sikh and Zoroastrian (Parsis) pursuing studies in India in a Government or recognized private school/Institute/college/university.

In this regard, the following information/ instructions were issued to all DMWOs/DNOs in the State for the academic year 2022-23 for smooth implementation of aforesaid schemes:

1. During the year 2022-23, the online implementation of the Pre-Matric, Post Matric and Merit-cum-Means based scholarship schemes shall be done through the National Scholarship Portal (NSP) of the Government of India under URL: [www.scholarships.gov.in](http://www.scholarships.gov.in).
2. Only online applications under the Schemes will be accepted and no request for Offline applications will be entertained.

3. The detailed guidelines of three scholarship schemes and Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) with the timelines are available on the National Scholarship Portal (NSP).
4. Ministry has been initiated the process of inviting online applications for the aforesaid schemes, as per existing guidelines.
5. The District Minorities Welfare Officers/District Nodal Officers in the State should publicize the schemes through advertisements in leading newspapers and other popular means in their respective Districts to enable the minority students to avail the maximum benefits of these scholarship schemes.
6. To increase publicity of the aforesaid three scholarship schemes for minorities, efforts may also be made to place hoardings at District Collectorate Offices to promote the awareness for the minority students as well as Institution Registration on NSP portal etc.,
7. After giving publicity copies of paper clippings, photos, palm plates, posters and any other media shall sent to this office for record purpose.
8. All DMWOs/INOs/SNO in the State are requested to login with existing login details and update their profiles for the year 2022-23, duly following the instructions mentioned in NSP portal.

In addition to the existing instructions issued in the earlier years, certain actions to be taken by the District Minorities Welfare Officers/State Nodal Officer in the State for implementation of three scholarship schemes are enclosed in Annexure-II for strict compliance.

Further, it is to inform that, State-wise /Community wise physical allocation under three scholarship schemes for the year 2022-23 is yet to be done as the scheme and guidelines are likely to be revised shortly. Hence, the same shall be intimated separately in due course, so far as renewal applications (who got scholarships during 2021-22) are concerned, there is no target for them and all the renewal applications are eligible for scholarships during the year by giving their existing application IDs.

2.	Last date for application submission	30 <sup>th</sup> September, 2022
3.	L1 Verification (INO level) in respect of Pre-Matric Scholarship Scheme	16 <sup>th</sup> October, 2022
4.	L2 Verification (DNO/SNO/Ministry level) in respect Pre-Matric Scholarship Scheme	31 <sup>st</sup> October, 2022
5.	Defective application verification date	16 <sup>th</sup> October, 2022

**For Post-Matric/Top-Class/MCM Scholarship schemes:**

1.	Opening of NSP portal for submission of Post-Matric and Merit - cum-Means based scholarship applications.	20 <sup>th</sup> July, 2022
2.	Last date for application submission	31 <sup>st</sup> October, 2022
3.	L1 Verification (INO level) in respect of Pre-Matric Scholarship Scheme	15 <sup>th</sup> November, 2022
4.	L2 Verification (DNO/SNO/Ministry level) in respect Pre-Matric Scholarship Scheme	30 <sup>th</sup> November, 2022
5.	Defective application verification date	15 <sup>th</sup> November, 2022

Further, it is also informed that, in newly added districts, logins for three scholarship schemes will be allotted separately in NSP portal. For this separate information will be called for from newly added districts in prescribed proforma.

Hence, all the District Minorities Welfare Officers/District Nodal Officer in the State are requested to follow the above instructions scrupulously and publicize about three scholarship schemes for smoother implementation of 2022-23 GoI Scholarship schemes.
