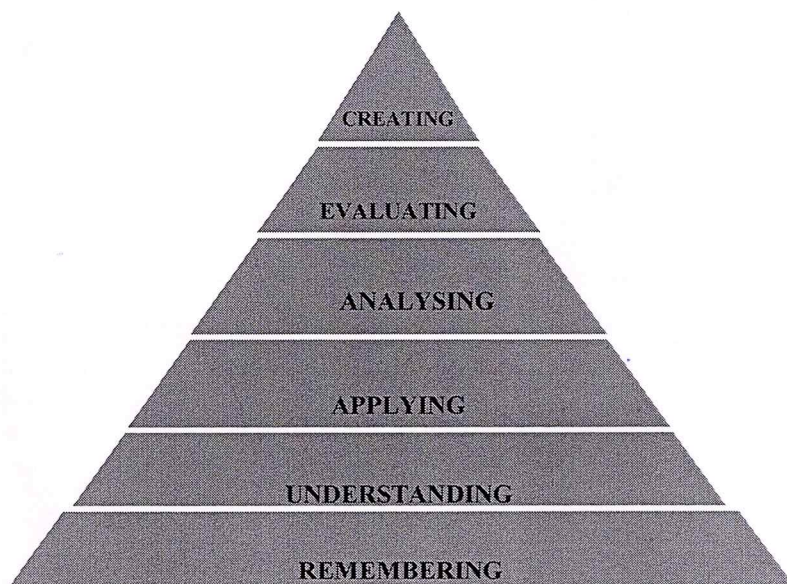


Fig: Bloom's Taxonomy


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CO is measured on the grades on which students are scored. The range of marks and the equivalent grade and grade points are shown below.

Evaluation and the level of attainment:

Knowledge and skill that students acquire in their subject and also their capacity for critical thinking, are evaluated through Continuous Internal Evaluation, End Semester Examinations and personal interaction. Attainment of these outcomes is excellent, with pass percentage is high and dropout rate is low. Majority students in Science, Arts & Commerce, and Education pass in first class (60%) and many with distinction (75%).

NSS: The University encourages creativity and social service amongst its students. University prides in being the largest university of Andhra Pradesh with 438 Colleges and 290 NSS units. NSS conducts various activities like blood donation camp, Plantation program, Distribution of groceries to the needy people during Covid-19.

All departments organize seminars, workshops, conferences, FDPs on their relevant fields dealing with social, ethical, environmental and technical issues. The awareness and sensitivity level is good, gauged from the appreciable student participation in activities of these issues. In the past five years 41 Ph. D. Degrees were awarded. Many of the students qualifying NET/JRF in their post graduate course in the university shows their interest in research and development.
