Having Consider the recommendation of the meeting of Sports Board the Vice – Chancellor is pleased to approve the resolutions of the above meeting held on 04.09.2019 for the Academic Year 2019-2020 as follows

### Resolutions

1. Resolved to enhance the Intercollegiate tournament expenditure from 10,000/- to 15,000/- which includes the Selection Committee members & Observer TA/DA and the selected players TA
2. Resolved that Each team has to pay 100/- for every match as officiating fee and officiating fee for cricket match is 300/- for every match
3. Resolved that In case the team reaches to further rounds DA & other allowances will be given beyond the proposed budget where as the proposed budget is planned for few days as per the nature of the game
4. Resolved that 70% of the sanctioned budget will be released as advance before to commencement of the tournament
5. Resolved that Sending the team/Individual tournament is based on the performance of the team/individual at selection trails / coaching camp and it will be decided by the concerned observer report and University authority, ANUR and the final decision will be taken by the University nominated committee
6. Resolved to Nominate a committee to finalize to the University teams participation at Inter University level The committee to authorise to recommend or to Stop the teams for the participation in the Inter University tournament based on the performance.

7. Resolved to grant 3<sup>rd</sup> AC fair to Coach and Manager who attend Inter University /South Zone/All India tournaments by submitting TA/DA claim form.
8. Resolved to layout 400mts standard track in the University Campus and also provide facility for Athletics events
9. Resolved to construct an open air theatre and provide sports equipment storage facility under the open air theatre to keep sports material
10. Resolved to direct the principal/organizing chairman to do Insurance to all the players and officials who are participating in the Inter University tournaments
11. Resolved to recommend to the University for conduct of re-examination for the players who participated in the Inter University Tournament during the days of the University Examination schedule.
12. Resolved to recommend the University to utilize the service of 2<sup>nd</sup> M.P.Ed students services as per the specialization to conduct outreach activities affiliated colleges to develop the standards of Identified events which are more benefits for the improve standard of University level to participate A I U Competition at later stage


Having Consider the recommendation of the meeting of Sports Board the Vice – Chancellor is pleased to approve the rules and regulations to be followed while organizing Inter Collegiate/Inter University tournaments finalized in the meeting held on 04.09.2019 for the Academic Year 2019-2020 as follows

**Rules and Regulations**

1. Every Player should have minimum 17 years to 25 years Age limit to participate in Tournament (UG students up to 5 years, from regular Intermediate & PG students 7 years from regular Intermediate completed), two (2) foreign students are allowed up to 28 years' age limit in Football. In case of duration, the organizing secretary is responsible.
2. Selection Committee Members who are working in affiliated colleges should have minimum 3 years' experience in UG / PG colleges.
3. Inter Collegiate Tournament observer should submit his report within two days after completion of tournament and Observer should stay at venue during tournament dates without fail
4. Allotted colleges has to fulfil required facilities to conduct Inter Collegiate tournaments otherwise the event will not be allotted or it will be cancelled if allotted.  
Sports Board Secretary and two members will visit the college to examine facilities.
5. Organizing Secretary should accompany with the team as manager to participate Inter University Tournaments.
6. Participants should bring Id cards & University Eligibility form along with 10<sup>th</sup>, Inter, Degree, Xerox copies duly attested, by the concerned college principal

7. All Inter University teams should attend photo session at University campus before attending to the Inter University tournament and copy of the same should be submitted along with Inter University tournament bills otherwise claim will not be considered
8. The organizing secretary should pay TA/DA to Selection Committee Members & observer the same day
9. Every organizing secretary should submit the bills within completion of inter University tournament within one month. Otherwise 5 % of the sanctioned amount will be deducted if the bills along with statement not submitted to the secretary sports board.
10. Either coach or manager should accompany team members.
11. While coming for railway concession forms, organizing secretary should authorise the names and other details of the players on letter head
12. The details of the coaching camp including dates, coaches etc. should submit to secretary sports board before beginning the coaching camp
13. Attendance certificate must submitted along with Inter University Tournament bills
14. While submitting bills for claim, the bills should be affixed on A4 size paper without fail, otherwise the bills will not be considered for claim and the claim bills should be counter signed by the Principal & Organizing secretary
15. The teams and other crew who are participating in Inter University tournament should bring passport size photos (Players – 2, Manager & Coach -1) to get eligibility form from Sports Board.
16. Organizing secretary should conduct tournament with qualified empires as per AIU Guide lines
17. Railway concessions tickets (Players) must be submit along with bills
