Sub: Proposal for Awareness generation and Capacity building Programs on drug demand reduction in colleges and universities.

Sir/Madam,

The Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment (MSJ&E), Government of India, New Delhi, is a nodal ministry for drug demand reduction in the country. A National Action Plan for drug demand reduction has been developed by the Ministry with a focus on taking nationwide initiatives of awareness creation and capacity building programmes to mitigate the growing menace of drug abuse specially among adolescent children and youth of schools and colleges.

In this regard, there was a felt need for having a wider coverage of schools, and colleges, nationwide by involving actively the various departments of educational institutions with networks spread over the country, (government and private sectors) and other stakeholders working for the welfare of adolescent, children and youth.

In pursuance to this recommendation, the National Institute of Social Defence, an autonomous body of MSJ&E, has been directed to organize various awareness creation and capacity building programmes in collaboration with some of the afore mentioned government and private institutions. We are grateful for your kind cooperation in organizing the aforementioned courses sanctioned to you in the last quarter of 2018-19, for which the report is awaited. We now request you to kindly submit a proposal for the current financial year 2019-20, for organizing i) one day awareness generation/sensitization programmes for students and teaching staff of colleges/universities, and ii) also conduct one day capacity building programmes for teaching faculties and representatives of social service wings of both colleges and universities. Capsule programmes/modules of the content and approach will be made available soon, open for modification if any, by the collaborating institutions.

It is also submitted that an amount of upto Rs. 50,000/- each towards entailing expenditure for organizing one day awareness generation programmes in colleges and universities and similarly Rs. 50,000/- for each of the one day (non-residential) training/capacity building programme exclusively meant for teaching faculties and representatives of social service wings, which will be supported by NISD. However, the financial outlay/heads of expenditure, UC, reporting and the implementation of these programmes may be adhered as per the enclosed guidelines prescribed by NISD.

A line of confirmation to this letter and plan of action for aforesaid programmes to collaborate with us in this endeavour, and further clarifications if any, may be send to this institute by mail or by speed post.
